MEMBERSHIP FEES ARE PAID AT THE RIDERS FIRST SHOW. THIS FEE HELPS COVER COSTS FOR STAFF, FACILITIES, GROUNDS MAINTENANCE, ARENA HARROWING & WATERING, SOUND SYSTEM, PORTA POTTIES, RIBBONS, PRIZES, ADMINISTRATION SOFTWARE, OFFICE SUPPLIES ETC.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. AGES ARE TAKEN AS OF JANUARY 1 OF THE CURRENT YEAR. LEAD LINE RIDERS ARE 8 YEARS AND UNDER. PEE WEE RIDERS ARE 11 AND UNDER. YOUTH RIDERS ARE 12 - 17. SENIOR RIDERS ARE 18+. JACK BENNY RIDERS ARE 40+.
2. **APPROVED ASTM HELMETS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED, BUT NOT MANDATORY. HELMET WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED AT EACH SHOW.**
3. RIDERS MUST SHOW PROOF OF CURRENT ONTARIO EQUESTRIAN MEMBERSHIP OR PROOF OF PRIVATE **INSURANCE MINIMUM OF \$2,000,000.**
4. **PATTERNS** WILL BE POSTED AT RING SIDE BY 8:30 AM.
5. **PLACINGS** WILL BE POSTED ON FACEBOOK FOR THE FIRST THREE SHOWS. THE FINAL SHOW RESULTS WILL BE POSTED AFTER THE BANQUET.
6. RIDERS NOT IN CONTROL OF THEIR HORSE WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE RING.
7. EXHIBITORS / HORSES IN **HALTER / SHOWMANSHIP** TO BE SHOWN IN AN ENGLISH BRIDLE WITH APPROPRIATE ENGLISH ATTIRE OR WESTERN LEATHER HALTER AND LEATHER LEAD WITH CHAIN WITH APPROPRIATE WESTERN ATTIRE. YOUTH CAN NOT SHOW A STALLION.
8. **ENGLISH - ATTIRE** - ALL CLOTHING MUST BE CLEAN AND NEAT. SHOW JACKET, SHIRT WITH PROPER COLLAR, JODHPURS OR BREECHES, FIELD BOOTS OR BLACK OR BROWN PADDOCK BOOTS WITH CLEAN MATCHING HALF CHAPS AND APPROVED HELMET. BLUNT SPURS ARE ALLOWED (UNROWELLED TYPE). CROPS ARE PERMITTED IN APPROPRIATE CLASSES.
9. **ENGLISH - TACK - BRIDLE** - ENGLISH TYPE SNAFFLE, PELHAM, OR KIMBERWICK. NO INHUMANE BITS WILL BE ALLOWED. SINGLE REIN PELHAM CONVERTERS ARE ALLOWED. DROP, FLASH OR FIGURE EIGHT NOSEBANDS AND STANDING OR RUNNING MARTINGALES ARE NOT ALLOWED. BREASTPLATES ARE OPTIONAL. **SADDLE** - OF ENGLISH TYPE, LEATHER, SYNTHETIC, SUEDE ARE ACCEPTABLE. WHITE SADDLE PADS SHOULD BE USED (COLOURED TRIM IS ACCEPTABLE). ANY TYPE OF BOOTS OR WRAPS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

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RULES & REGULATIONS

10. **WESTERN - ATTIRE** - ALL CLOTHING MUST BE CLEAN AND NEAT. WESTERN SHIRT WITH A COLLAR, WESTERN TROUSERS OR WESTERN JEANS (DARK COLOUR) (NO LIGHT WASH BLUE JEANS OR RIPS OR TEARS), BOOTS AND HAT (HELMETS ARE ENCOURAGED). SHORT SLEEVES ARE NOT PERMITTED. SPURS ARE OPTIONAL AND SHOULD BE HUMANE AND BLUNT ENDED OR SMALL ROWELL. CHAPS ARE OPTIONAL. CHINKS ARE OPTIONAL IN RANCH CLASSES ONLY. NO BATWING CHAPS.
11. **WESTERN - TACK - BRIDLE** - OF WESTERN TYPE HEADSTALLS TO BE USED, EITHER WITH A BROWBAND, ONE EAR OR TWO, BUT NO NOSEBAND. SPLIT REINS OR CLOSED REINS WITH ROMEL ARE ACCEPTABLE. HORSES OVER 5 YEARS OLD TO USE A SHANK BIT AND BE NECK REINED. HORSES 5 YEARS OLD AND UNDER MAY USE A SNAFFLE BIT OR BOSALS AND BE DIRECT REINED. IF UNDER 5 YEARS, PROOF OF AGE MUST BE SHOWN IF ASKED BY THE COMMITTEE, RING STEWARD OR JUDGE. CURB CHAINS MAY BE USED BUT MUST BE AT LEAST 1/2" IN WIDTH AND LIE FLAT. HACKAMORES, TIE DOWNS, DRAW REINS, TRAINING MARTINGALES ARE PROHIBITED IN ALL CLASSES. **SADDLE** - OF ANY WESTERN TYPE MAY BE USED BUT MUST FIT THE HORSE AND RIDER. SADDLE PAD MUST BE NEAT AND CLEAN AND MAY BE OF ANY COLOUR. SILVER EQUIPMENT MAY BE USED BUT SHALL NOT BE GIVEN PREFERENCE OVER GOOD WORKING EQUIPMENT. ALL TACK SHOULD HAVE MINIMAL SILVER FOR RANCH CLASSES. ANY TYPE OF BOOTS OR WRAPS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
12. **BITLESS BRIDLES** - ARE ALLOWED.
13. **RIDERS CAN NOT CROSS ENTER FROM OPEN WALK/JOG/TROT TO LOPE/CANTER CLASSES (YOUTH/SENIOR/JACK BENNY/RANCH).**
14. ALL LAS HORSE SHOWS WILL FOLLOW THE EC RULEBOOK. [HTTPS://EQUESTRIAN.CA/COMPETE/ATHLETE-RESOURCES/RULEBOOKS/](https://equestrian.ca/compete/athlete-resources/rulebooks/)
15. EXHIBITORS MUST ENTER AND EXIT THE RING AT A WALK.
16. **WEATHER:** IF A SHOW IS CANCELLED DUE TO WEATHER, WE WILL TRY TO RESCHEDULE.
17. THESE RULES CAN BE ALTERED BY THE COMMITTEE AT ANY TIME AS THEY SEE FIT.
18. **THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL. LACK OF COURTESY TO THE JUDGE, COMMITTEE AND VOLUNTEERS COULD RESULT IN THE EXPULSION FROM THE RING.**

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

HALTER & SHOWMANSHIP DIVISION

HALTER - MARE & GELDING/STALLION - JUDGED ON THE CONFIRMATION OF THE HORSE. ALL HORSES WILL WALK IN THE RING INDIVIDUALLY, SET UP AT THE FIRST CONE, ONCE ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE JUDGE, WALK TO THE JUDGE. AS THE HORSE APPROACHES, THE JUDGE WILL STEP TO THE SIDE TO ALLOW THE HORSE TO TROT AWAY AND INTO LINE (JUDGES' DISCRETION - EITHER TAILS TO THE RAIL OR NOSE TO TAIL) FOR INDIVIDUAL INSPECTION.

PEE WEE SHOWMANSHIP - 11 AND UNDER. JUDGED ON THE EXHIBITOR'S SHOWMANSHIP AND PRESENTATION. A PATTERN WILL BE POSTED PRIOR TO THE CLASS. EXHIBITORS WILL LINE UP AT THE JUDGE'S DISCRETION. EACH EXHIBITOR WILL EXECUTE THE PATTERN ONE PARTICIPANT AT A TIME.

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP - 12 - 17 YEARS OLD. JUDGED ON THE EXHIBITOR'S SHOWMANSHIP AND PRESENTATION. A PATTERN WILL BE POSTED PRIOR TO THE CLASS. EXHIBITORS WILL LINE UP AT THE JUDGE'S DISCRETION. EACH EXHIBITOR WILL EXECUTE THE PATTERN ONE PARTICIPANT AT A TIME.

SENIOR SHOWMANSHIP - 18 AND OLDER. JUDGED ON THE EXHIBITOR'S SHOWMANSHIP AND PRESENTATION. A PATTERN WILL BE POSTED PRIOR TO THE CLASS. EXHIBITORS WILL LINE UP AT THE JUDGE'S DISCRETION. EACH EXHIBITOR WILL EXECUTE THE PATTERN ONE PARTICIPANT AT A TIME.

LEAD LINE DIVISION (8 YEARS AND UNDER)

LEAD LINE - WALK ONLY - HORSES MUST BE LED BY AN ADULT (18 YEARS OR OLDER) WITH A BRIDLE ALONG WITH A HALTER AND SHANK OVERTOP OF THE BRIDLE. A SPOTTER FOR YOUNG RIDERS IS ENCOURAGED. EXHIBITOR WILL BE ASKED TO WALK, HALT AND BACK UP. EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS CLASS CAN ONLY ENTER LEAD LINE, HALTER, SHOWMANSHIP AND IN HAND CLASSES.

LEAD LINE COMMAND - WALK ONLY - HORSES MUST BE LED BY AN ADULT (18 YEARS OR OLDER) WITH A BRIDLE ALONG WITH A HALTER AND SHANK OVERTOP OF THE BRIDLE. A SPOTTER FOR YOUNG RIDERS IS ENCOURAGED. EXHIBITOR WILL BE ASKED TO FOLLOW COMMANDS SUCH AS: WALK, HALT AND BACK UP. EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS CLASS CAN ONLY ENTER LEAD LINE, HALTER, SHOWMANSHIP AND IN HAND CLASSES.



CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

PEE WEE DIVISION

WALK/JOG/TROT (11 YEARS AND UNDER)

PEE WEE ENGLISH / WESTERN PLEASURE -

EXHIBITORS MUST RIDE THE HORSE AND NOT BE LED. EXHIBITORS WILL BE ASKED TO WALK AND JOG/TROT BOTH DIRECTIONS OF THE RING AND WILL BE JUDGED ON THE WAY OF GOING OF THE HORSE. THE HORSE SHOULD BE A PLEASURE TO RIDE. WESTERN RIDERS MAY RIDE WITH BOTH HANDS. EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS CLASS CAN ONLY ENTER IN PEE WEE CLASSES, HALTER, SHOWMANSHIP, IN HAND AND WALK/JOG/TROT DIVISION.

PEE WEE ENGLISH EQUITATION / WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP

(NO PATTERN) - EXHIBITORS MUST RIDE THE HORSE AND NOT BE LED. EXHIBITORS WILL BE ASKED TO WALK AND JOG/TROT BOTH DIRECTIONS OF THE RING AND WILL BE JUDGED ON THE RIDER'S SEAT, HANDS, SUITABILITY OF HORSE AND RIDER AND PERFORMANCE. RIDERS MAY BE ASKED TO BACK UP. WESTERN RIDERS MAY RIDE WITH BOTH HANDS. EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS CLASS CAN ONLY ENTER IN PEE WEE CLASSES, HALTER, SHOWMANSHIP, IN HAND AND WALK/JOG/TROT DIVISION.

PEE WEE ENGLISH / WESTERN COMMAND -

COMMANDS WILL BE ANNOUNCED; LAST RIDER(S) TO PERFORM THE COMMAND WILL BE CALLED INTO THE MIDDLE OF THE RING. COMMANDS WILL BE CALLED UNTIL THERE IS ONE RIDER LEFT. JUDGE MAY ASK FOR (BUT NOT LIMITED TO): WALK, JOG/TROT, HALT AND BACK UP. EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS CLASS CAN ONLY ENTER IN PEE WEE CLASSES, HALTER, SHOWMANSHIP, IN HAND AND WALK/JOG/TROT DIVISION.

YEAR END POINTS

YEAR END POINTS WILL BE CALCULATED DEPENDING ON THE NUMBER OF HORSES IN EACH CLASS.

IF THERE IS 1 HORSE THEY ARE AWARDED 1 POINT. IF THERE ARE 10 HORSES, 1ST PLACE WILL RECEIVE 10 POINTS, 2ND PLACE WILL RECEIVE 9 POINTS ETC.

EVERYONE PAST 5TH PLACE WILL RECEIVE 1 POINT.

EXHIBITOR MUST COMPETE IN AT LEAST THREE OF THE FOUR SHOWS TO QUALIFY FOR YEAR END AWARDS.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

WALK/JOG/TROT DIVISION - WALK/JOG/TROT

(ANY AGE RIDER - IF A RIDER MOVES UP TO A LOPE/CANTER CLASS, THEY CAN NOT RETURN TO W/J/T)

EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS DIVISION CAN ONLY ENTER OPEN W/J/T, HALTER, SHOWMANSHIP AND IN HAND.

ENGLISH PLEASURE - JUDGED ON THE WAY OF GOING OF THE HORSE. THE HORSE SHOULD BE A PLEASURE TO RIDE WITH LIGHT MAINTAINED REIN CONTACT AT ALL GAITS.

ENGLISH EQUITATION - JUDGED ON THE RIDER'S SEAT, HANDS, SUITABILITY OF HORSE AND RIDER AND PERFORMANCE. JUDGE MAY ALSO ASK FOR AN EXTENDED OR COLLECTED TROT AND BACK UP. EXHIBITORS MAY BE ASKED TO PERFORM A PATTERN AS WELL AS RAIL WORK.

HUNTER HACK - RIDERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO JUMP TWO FENCES (CROSS RAILS). RAIL WORK WILL FOLLOW AT THE WALK AND TROT BOTH DIRECTIONS. HORSES ARE JUDGED ON MANNERS AND WAY OF GOING, BOTH ON THE FLAT AND OVER FENCES.

WESTERN PLEASURE - JUDGED ON THE WAY OF GOING OF THE HORSE. THE HORSE SHOULD BE A PLEASURE TO RIDE WITH A LOOSE REIN. TO BE SHOWN AT THE WALK AND JOG.

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP - JUDGED ON THE RIDER'S SEAT, HANDS, SUITABILITY OF HORSE AND RIDER AND PERFORMANCE. TO BE SHOWN AT THE WALK AND JOG. JUDGE MAY ALSO ASK TO EXTEND THE JOG AND BACK UP.

EXHIBITORS MAY BE ASKED TO PERFORM A PATTERN AS WELL AS RAIL WORK.

WESTERN TRAIL - TO BE SHOWN IN WESTERN TACK AND ATTIRE. PATTERN WILL BE POSTED. EXHIBITORS WILL BE ASKED TO COMPLETE DIFFERENT OBSTACLES IN A PATTERN AT A WALK, JOG, SIDE PASS AND BACK UP ON A LOOSE REIN. RIDERS MAY NOT CHANGE HANDS ON REINS OTHER THAN AT THE GATE. JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, WAY OF GOING AND MANNERS. 60 SECONDS OR TWO ATTEMPTS WILL BE GIVEN PER OBSTACLE, THEN THE EXHIBITOR MUST MOVE ONTO THE NEXT OBSTACLE. NATURAL OBSTACLES MAY INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: BRIDGE, GATE, MAILBOX, WALK/JOG POLES, SIDE PASS AND BACK UP. THIS IS NOT A TIMED EVENT.

COMMAND - OPEN TO ENGLISH & WESTERN RIDERS. COMMANDS WILL BE ANNOUNCED; LAST RIDER(S) TO PERFORM THE COMMAND WILL BE CALLED INTO THE MIDDLE OF THE RING. COMMANDS WILL BE CALLED UNTIL THERE IS ONE RIDER LEFT. JUDGE MAY ASK FOR (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) WALK, JOG/TROT, BACK UP, HALT, CHANGE REIN/REVERSE, DISMOUNT, MOUNT AND SIDE PASS.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

IN HAND DIVISION - WALK/JOG/TROT

JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, WAY OF GOING AND MANNERS. 60 SECONDS OR TWO ATTEMPTS WILL BE GIVEN PER OBSTACLE, THEN THE EXHIBITOR MUST MOVE ONTO THE NEXT OBSTACLE. NATURAL OBSTACLES MAY INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: BRIDGE, GATE, MAILBOX, WALK/JOG POLES, SIDE PASS AND BACK UP. THIS IS NOT A TIMED EVENT.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

YOUTH | SENIOR | JACK BENNY DIVISIONS

ENGLISH PLEASURE - JUDGED ON THE WAY OF GOING OF THE HORSE. THE HORSE SHOULD BE A PLEASURE TO RIDE WITH LIGHT MAINTAINED REIN CONTACT AT ALL GAITS. TO BE SHOWN AT THE WALK, TROT AND CANTER.

ENGLISH EQUITATION - JUDGED ON THE RIDER'S SEAT, HANDS, SUITABILITY OF HORSE AND RIDER AND PERFORMANCE. TO BE SHOWN AT THE WALK, TROT AND CANTER. JUDGE MAY ALSO ASK FOR AN EXTENDED OR COLLECTED TROT/CANTER AND BACK UP. EXHIBITORS MAY BE ASKED TO PERFORM A PATTERN AS WELL AS RAIL WORK.

HUNTER HACK - RIDERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO JUMP TWO FENCES (CROSS RAILS OR SMALL VERTICAL). RAIL WORK WILL FOLLOW AT THE WALK, TROT AND CANTER BOTH DIRECTIONS. HORSES ARE JUDGED ON MANNERS AND WAY OF GOING, BOTH ON THE FLAT AND OVER FENCES.

WESTERN PLEASURE - JUDGED ON THE WAY OF GOING OF THE HORSE. THE HORSE SHOULD BE A PLEASURE TO RIDE WITH A LOOSE REIN. TO BE SHOWN AT THE WALK, JOG AND LOPE.

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP - JUDGED ON THE RIDER'S SEAT, HANDS, SUITABILITY OF HORSE AND RIDER AND PERFORMANCE. TO BE SHOWN AT THE WALK, JOG AND LOPE. JUDGE MAY ALSO ASK TO EXTEND THE JOG/LOPE AND BACK UP. EXHIBITORS MAY BE ASKED TO PERFORM A PATTERN AS WELL AS RAIL WORK.

WESTERN TRAIL - TO BE SHOWN IN WESTERN TACK AND ATTIRE. PATTERN WILL BE POSTED. EXHIBITORS WILL BE ASKED TO COMPLETE DIFFERENT OBSTACLES IN A PATTERN AT A WALK, JOG, LOPE, SIDE PASS AND BACK UP. RIDERS MAY NOT CHANGE HANDS ON REINS OTHER THAN AT THE GATE. JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, WAY OF GOING AND MANNERS. 60 SECONDS OR TWO ATTEMPTS WILL BE GIVEN PER OBSTACLE, THEN THE EXHIBITOR MUST MOVE ONTO THE NEXT OBSTACLE. NATURAL OBSTACLES MAY INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: BRIDGE, GATE, MAILBOX, WALK/JOG/LOPE POLES, SIDE PASS AND BACK UP. THIS IS NOT A TIMED EVENT.

COMMAND – OPEN TO ENGLISH & WESTERN RIDERS. COMMANDS WILL BE ANNOUNCED; LAST RIDER(S) TO PERFORM THE COMMAND WILL BE CALLED INTO THE MIDDLE OF THE RING. COMMANDS WILL BE CALLED UNTIL THERE IS ONE RIDER LEFT. JUDGE MAY ASK FOR (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) WALK, JOG/TROT, LOPE/CANTER, COUNTER LOPE/CANTER, HAND GALLOP, BACK UP, HALT, CHANGE REIN/REVERSE, DISMOUNT, MOUNT AND SIDE PASS.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

RANCH DIVISION

RANCH RAIL - EXHIBITOR MAY BE ASKED FOR WALK, JOG, TROT, EXTENDED TROT, LOPE, AND EXTENDED LOPE. SHOWN ON THE RAIL. NO PATTERN. THE RANCH RAIL PLEASURE CLASS MEASURES THE ABILITY OF THE HORSE TO BE A PLEASURE TO RIDE WHILE BEING USED AS A MEANS OF CONVEYANCE FROM ONE RANCH TASK TO ANOTHER AND SHOULD REFLECT THE VERSATILITY, ATTITUDE AND MOVEMENT OF A WORKING HORSE. THE HORSE SHOULD BE RIDDEN ON A RELATIVELY LOOSE REIN WITH LIGHT CONTACT AND WITHOUT REQUIRING UNDUE RESTRAINT. HORSES REGARDLESS OF THEIR AGE MAY BE RIDDEN WITH ONE HAND AND A STANDARD WESTERN BIT OR WITH ONE OR TWO HANDS WITH A SNAFFLE BIT OR BOSAL. WHEN EXHIBITING IN A SNAFFLE BIT OR BOSAL, AN EXHIBITOR MAY SWITCH BETWEEN TWO HANDS AND ONE HAND ON THE REINS AT ANY TIME. SITTING THE REGULAR TROT AND LOPE IS RECOMMENDED; THOUGH STANDING IN THE STIRRUPS AT THE EXTENDED TROT AND EXTENDED LOPE, OR POSTING THE EXTENDED TROT IS ACCEPTABLE. TOUCHING OR HOLDING THE SADDLE HORN IS ACCEPTABLE. TACK SHOULD LOOK LIKE WORKING TACK INCLUDING A BACK CINCH AND BREAST STRAP (BUT NOT REQUIRED). SILVER ON SADDLES AND "BLING" IS DISCOURAGED, BUT NOT PENALIZED. CHAPS/CHINKS OPTIONAL. EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS CLASS CAN CROSS ENTER INTO YOUTH, SENIOR/JACK BENNY AND IN HAND.

RANCH RIDING - SEE RANCH RAIL - EXHIBITORS WILL BE ASKED TO PERFORM A PATTERN. OPTIONAL MANEUVERS ARE SIDEPASS, TURNS OF 360 DEGREES OR MORE, CHANGE OF LEAD (FLYING OR SIMPLE) (A SIMPLE CHANGE MUST BE MADE WITHIN THREE STRIDES), WALK, JOG OR LOPE OVER POLES OR OTHER REASONABLE MANEUVERS. EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS CLASS CAN CROSS ENTER INTO YOUTH, SENIOR/JACK BENNY AND IN HAND.

RANCH TRAIL - SEE RANCH RAIL - JUDGED ON HORSE'S SUITABILITY FOR EVERY-DAY RANCH WORK BY TESTING THEIR ABILITY TO NAVIGATE A SERIES OF OBSTACLES. MANDATORY ELEMENTS: WALK, TROT, LOPE (OVER LOGS), GATE, BACKING, BRIDGE, SIDEPASS AND DRAGGING (DALLIED TO SADDLE). COULD BE ASKED TO ROPE AND GROUND TIE. EXHIBITORS ENTERING IN THIS CLASS CAN CROSS ENTER INTO YOUTH, SENIOR/JACK BENNY AND IN HAND.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

MYSTERY CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

STEADY HAND: EXHIBITORS ARE GIVEN A PLASTIC CUP OF WATER, THEN PERFORM CERTAIN MANEUVRES AT CERTAIN GAITS. THE EXHIBITOR WITH THE MOST AMOUNT OF WATER LEFT IN THEIR CUP AT THE END OF THE CLASS WINS.

CARROT RACE: EXHIBITORS WILL RIDE AT ANY GAIT TO THE FAR END OF THE RING, DISMOUNT AND THEIR HORSE HAS TO PICK UP THE CARROT WITHOUT ANY ASSISTANCE, AND THEN LEAD YOUR HORSE (WALK, JOG/TROT) ACROSS THE FINISH LINE. FIRST EXHIBITOR AND HORSE TO CROSS THE FINISH LINE WINS.

BOOT SCRAMBLE: EXHIBITORS WILL BE ASKED TO TAKE OFF THEIR BOOTS. THEY WILL RIDE TO THE FAR SIDE OF THE RING, DISMOUNT, AND FIND THEIR BOOTS IN THE PILE, PUT THEM ON AND LEAD THEIR HORSE ACROSS THE FINISH LINE. FIRST EXHIBITOR AND HORSE TO CROSS THE FINISH LINE WINS.

MUSICAL PAILS/STALLS: EXHIBITORS WILL GO AROUND THE RING AT A JOG/TROT. WHEN THE MUSIC STOPS, EXHIBITORS MUST DISMOUNT AND LEAD THEIR HORSE TO THE MIDDLE OF THE RING AND SIT ON A PAIL. EXHIBITORS WITHOUT A PAIL TO SIT ON ARE ELIMINATED. LAST REMAINING EXHIBITOR WINS.

EGG AND SPOON: EXHIBITORS ARE GIVEN A SPOON AND AN EGG THEN PERFORM CERTAIN MANEUVRES AT CERTAIN GAITS. THE EXHIBITOR LEFT WITH THEIR EGG STILL ON THEIR SPOON AT THE END OF THE CLASS WINS.
